## Team Application for TEC

Serving on Team for a TEC weekend can be both a rewarding and challenging experience. It is both awesome and humbling to watch God form and use a Team to minister to that weekend's participants. Although their attention is focused on the retreatants, many Team members discover that God ministers every bit as powerfully to them as to the young adults on the weekend.

Likewise, serving on Team often forces the members to look deeply into their own hearts and souls and examine their own openness (or lack thereof) to God's will. Often, they find themselves caught in the struggle between pride and humility, between God's will and their own. Sometimes they must face wounds long ago bandaged but never fully healed.

God brings all of this together to demand a *metanoia* from each Team member, every time they serve on Team.

**Our main focus as a TEC Team** is to model for the weekend participants the values of Christian living as understood by the Roman Catholic Church—an understanding based on Scripture, Tradition, community, and participation in the Holy Sacraments.

### **Responsibilities / Expectations of Team Members** include the following:

- Actively participate in the sacrament of Eucharist at least weekly.
- Attend the sacrament of Reconciliation at least once in preparation for the weekend.
- Faithfully present the teachings of and live in faithful communion with the Catholic Church.
- Actively participate in some ministry or church activity outside of TEC—small communities, youth groups, liturgical ministers, religious education, and soup kitchens are just a few examples.
- Serve in whatever capacity (Wheat, Resource, or Music) you are asked.
- Attend all Team meetings, as well as any additional necessary meetings for the Wheat Team, Music Team, or Resource Team, as assigned. (*Fixed meeting dates and times are available on the website listed above.*)
- Come on Thursday evening to assist in setup, the Kick-off, and other Team night activities. Remain after the retreat ends on Sunday evening for very short team meeting and any remaining cleanup.
- Attend the weekend Reunion and the Team Review after the weekend.
- Follow-up with the retreatants after the weekend for one year, inviting them to TEC functions such as service projects and future Hoots and Kick-Offs, etc. Specifically, this includes a personal commitment to pray daily for the retreatants.
- Agree to and support Rocky Mountain TEC's Safe Environment policies.
- Attend (or have attended) an Archdiocesan VIRTUS (safe environment) training.
- Team fee is \$85 (financial assistance is available).
